On May 28, 2010, Professor CARLOS MARÍA ROMEO CASABONA was awarded the title of *Doctor Honoris Causa* by the Pontifical Catholic University of Minas, located in the city of Belo Horizonte, in the state of Minas Gerais, Brazil.

This is the sixth doctorate *honoris causa* Professor Romeo Casabona has received. He has previously received this title from the Private University of Tacna, the National University of St Augustin of Arequipa, the Catholic University of Santa María (Arequipa) and the Private University of Moquegua, in Peru, and from the University of La Laguna (Tenerife).

The award ceremony was attended by several of Professor Romeo Casabona's Professor and student colleagues from Spain and Brazil, who travelled from the Spanish universities of La Laguna, Deusto, the Basque Country/EHU, Zaragoza, Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, La Rioja and the Autonomous University of Barcelona as well as and from other Brazilian Universities.
